EASY JAZZ was urged along on the outside, chased while off the rail on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. REDHOTRUSH quickly sped clear, dictated terms while inside on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and proved no match for the winner while well clear for the place. KNOT FLOYD was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and was best of the rest. BLUEHARD was well placed in third position, dropped back while inside on the turn and came up empty. STORM HALF was ridden along at the rear, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. RIVERBOAT BANDIT was ridden along at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. FREEDOM RUN stumbled very badly at the start, fell to his face and unseated the rider.
