NAMESAKE broke alertly, stalked PROFIT EATER from early on, then closed determinedly to prevail. PROFIT EATER clear early, remained clear for the drive, then could not hold on. CHIEF WILDCAT forwardly placed along the inside, eased out in the lane but could make little impact. PROFESIONAL GRADE under stout restraint early, had no response. SALTGRASS TRAIL well back to the drive, was no real threat. ILLEGAL TICKET saved ground too no avail. SOUTHERN SOPRANO forwardly placed three wide, weakened. CRIMSON VIEW raced wide.
