Footnotes

KISSERL IS MY NAME chased the pace through the turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and got up near the wire under strong urging. DYNAMIC RESOURCE tracked the pace, inherited the lead leaving the backstretch, controlled the action on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, led gamely into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. MATIAS broke near the back of the field, moved up while ridden along, raced two to three wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. RILEY'S VOO DOO was urged along while just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed kick. GREAT PLANET was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail at the top of

the stretch and failed to rally. NEVER SAY QUIT broke a bit slow, was ridden along towards the rear while on the outside, moved in to save ground on the turn, came out in the stretch drive and improved position. MAJOR RYAN O'QUINN chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. MY DADDY HEIR was recalcitrant behind the gate, showed good speed, set the pace, bore out badly leaving the backstretch, raced extremely wide on the turn and was eased but walked off. COLE'S LAND was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. COHEN'S BANDITO was ridden along in the back half of the field, went four wide on the turn and was no factor. AUSTIN'S ALABI was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn and failed to respond. ROGE'S CHEMO broke very slow, spotted the field around five or six lengths, went three to four wide on the turn and never reached contention. LIL RED MACHINE broke a bit slow, dropped well behind while inside on the turn and was outrun.
