COLLEGE FUND broke awkwardly and was off about two lengths slow, went five wide on the first turn, moved in entering the backstretch, raced well off the pace, commenced a rally on the far turn, gained fast coming to the quarter-pole, took the lead in upper stretch, edged clear near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. ZARROZZI broke in and hit the gate, raced two to three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, advanced while inside on the far turn, moved off the rail coming to the quarter-pole, gained ground into the final furlong, drifted out under left hand urging near the sixteenth-pole and got up at the wire for the place. CHEER FOR GOLD went three wide on the first turn, raced in the front half of the field, advanced four then three wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled with COLLEGE FUND into the final sixteenth then was outfinished and caught for the

place at the wire. PIANO RULES raced five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and improved position. UNLIMITED GITGO raced inside on the first turn, dropped well off the pace, was urged along while five to six wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. LOUISIANA PUDDLES raced four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, moved to six wide near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. FOREVER DIAMONDS set the clear pace while off the rail, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired. CYS HOPE shifted four wide midway through the first turn, raced well off the pace, advanced five then four wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into upper stretch but came up empty. LONE STAR PIE lagged well back in the field while on the inside, saved ground into the stretch, moved out outside the furlong marker and failed to threaten. WANTED ALIVE went six wide early on the first turn, made his way to four wide by the end of that turn, raced in the second flight, came up empty while three wide on the far turn and stopped. WHITE CYPRESS raced four wide on the first turn and showed little. PRINCESS'S NEW MAN was hustled from the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, came up empty on the far turn and retreated.
