MY PRINCESS DAWN was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker then drew clear under strong urging. MY DAUGHTER'S SONG quickly sped clear, set the pace while off the rail, was asked for her best in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. CHEETAH PANTS chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and weakened while clear for the show. BELLINIZIA dropped back while ridden along, fell far behind the rest of the field, raced near the inside on the turn and failed to threaten. BRIDGE NIGHT (GB) was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally. SHARP SARITA was ridden along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to respond.
