POLLY'S FLEET reserved early, went after ROYAL BANDITA around the final turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, drew out and held on. PLEASANT PERFORMER saved ground while unhurried, remained inside to rally, eased out in upper stretch and was too late. ROYAL BANDITA clear early, was displaced in upper stretch and lasted for third. COME ON BERTIE raced wide and had no rally. PASS THE SILVER angled in before the first turn, remained inside while advancing down the backstretch, offered her best and flattened out. WINTER RUN saved ground and had no rally. AS GREAT AS SHE IS forwardly placed, gave way after turning for home. JUNE IN GREEN BAY four wide early, gave way after a half. AVIDE failed to menace. GALA OLD TIME bobbled just after the start, raced three wide around the first turn and then dropped back.
