CLASSIC WOMAN close up from the inside, angled out for the drive and was up for the place. RITA'S TRICK moved up quickly, vied between rivals, loomed boldly and finished gamely. COLLECT THE CASH prominent while off the rail, had no rally. PRAIRIE PIONEER improved position. DIXIE DAZZLE saved ground and was outrun. GO FOR PUDDIN broke alertly, vied for the lead from the inside and weakened in the drive. CAM'A'RONEY had no speed and was not a threat. DIABLO'S VILLA saved ground and faded. SUMMIT ASSAULT always back.
