Footnotes

LADY BURNER prompted the pace on the inside, took the lead near the half-mile pole, inched clear on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip at the top of the stretch, drew off into the final furlong and maintained a safe advantage under strong urging. POUR ME OUT settled on the inside, was urged along while continuing to save ground on the far turn, passed a few rivals into the final furlong, moved off the inside near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place. DOLLAR COTTON went four wide on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear, raced off the rail while urged along on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, was guided out in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly for the show. OH WHAT A BABE settled off the pace, was ridden along while inside on the far turn, held a good striking position into the stretch but lacked the needed response. MISS MARDI GRAS raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, brushed with GRAS shortly thereafter then had nothing left. BREEZIN INTENSITY raced three wide on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch and failed to respond. GRAS brushed with a rival after the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch, brushed with MISS MARDI GRAS shortly thereafter and tired. LITTLE RED LEXIE brushed with a rival after the start, raced two to three wide on the first turn, set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead near the half-mile pole, chased on the far turn and faded. ISLAND STREAM was taken up at the start and quickly dropped a few lengths behind the field, raced five wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and faltered.
