MAJOR PRINCE was well rated while off the rail, responded well when set down in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. GLORIOUS STRIKE raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged some while off the rail on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved up between rivals entering the final furlong and finished with good energy. WILS REWARD was well placed on the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and weakened while best of the rest. AROUSAL was taken in hand while off heels nearing the first turn, raced just off the pace while in hand, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide into the stretch and came up empty. EXCESSIVE ASSAULT raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and tired. EMPTY PAGES settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. PURE HOME BREW went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and had nothing left.
