**Footnotes**

TYTUS broke through the gate prior to the start, in the race he hopped at the break, he angled to the inside going to the first turn, advanced between foes around the second turn, was angled out for the drive and finished determinedly to get up. REPORTING FOR DUTY crossed to the inside going to the first turn, settled down the backstretch, advanced around the second turn, angled out in upper stretch, split foes late and just missed. ELLUNA raced inside to nearing the drive, was steered out after turning for home, closed gamely but was out finished. SCAT THIEF close up early, bid outside SIR WINSTON around the second turn, took over in upper stretch, ducked in just after and weakened late. WHO LET THE CAT IN five wide around the first turn, stalked the leaders three wide, loomed approaching the drive and then gave way. SIR WINSTON set the pace to before the drive and then faltered. OLLIE JET six wide around the first turn, came three wide around the second turn and was not a threat. DEGRAFF four wide early, was outrun. KON KRETE KID tired. TACTICAL JOE three wide early, gave way. INDIAN CAMP showed little. PRECAUTIONARY broke through the gate prior to the start, in the race he dropped back.
