### Footnotes

MISS MICHELLE was rated while under a snug hold, remained on hold while patient on the turn, shifted four wide and was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied under strong hand urging, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under right hand urging. NEED AN ANGEL settled on the inside of SLAM BEST, lugged out a bit while four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied in the final furlong and closed determinedly but missed. OXFORD MISS brushed with a rival at the start, showed good speed and set the pace, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, responded well when put to a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, switched to a left-handed whip just inside the furlong marker, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the show. CHAMPAGNE TOMMIE tracked the pace, chased three wide on the turn, made a mild bid into the stretch, failed to match strides with OXFORD MISS near the three-sixteenths pole, chased that rival into the final furlong and weakened. STONE FREE lunged outward at the start and brushed with OXFORD MISS then was asked, took an awkward stride near the inside in the early going, moved up to contest the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, drafted just behind the leader while saving ground on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed response. SLAM BEST was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
