### Footnotes

CARSON'S HONOR was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked in upper stretch, extended the lead into the final furlong and proved much the best under steady urging. STRIKING HIGHT brushed with a rival at the start then was in tight and taken in hand, raced near the back of the field while reserved, waited while off the rail on the far turn, was blocked at the top of the stretch, moved to the outside for room and got up for the place. SPEIGHTSTOWN SON raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the winner into upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. STAND raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was taken in hand near the half-mile pole, came under some urging while four to five wide on the far turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and improved position. ATTEMPTED HUMOR bumped with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, moved out near the seven-sixteenths pole, went two to three wide on the far turn, waited while blocked at the top of the stretch, moved to the inside then bumped with BURT'S A STITCH and lacked the needed response. AUTOBEACAT raced three then two wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under a stronger hold while in traffic near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three then four wide on the far turn, was asked for more in upper stretch and failed to rally. JIMANATOR was unhurried near the

back, raced four to five wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide nearing the quarter-pole, bobbed in upper stretch and also failed to rally. BURT'S A STITCH raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, chased while off the rail on the far turn, bumped with ATTEMPTED HUMOR while tiring near the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. BIG STICK bumped with a rival at the start, was rated on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and dropped out. (Rail at 10 Feet)
