SKIPAMISS raced wide, loomed a threat and then failed to sustain her bid. INIS allowed to settle, advanced between foes and then could make little impact. BEST FOOT FORWARD forced the pace until the drive and weakened. QUEEN'S BOUQUET allowed to settle, was no real threat. KISSALYSSA raced wide and weakened. BABETH (BRZ) saved ground and had no rally. STOMPING forward while three wide, faltered.
