SPLENDID APPEAL forwardly placed three wide, bid outside the leaders before the drive, surged clear and proved best while kept to the task. MORALITY reluctant to load, raced between foes going to the turn, rallied from along the rail and was best of the rest. TAPIT AGAIN exchanged brushes with SNAGS PICK after the break, was well back to before the drive, swung out and passed tiring foes. PREMO'S SUCCESS out footed early, moved up around the turn, then had no final kick. ATLANTIC RIDER vied for the lead to the drive, was overtaken by SPLENDID APPEAL, eased out and faltered. SADDLE RIDGE hustled up outside ATLANTIC RIDER to vie for the lead going to the turn, faltered inside the final furlong. EASTERNER saved ground to no avail. SNAGS PICK came in at the break, exchanged brushes with TAPIT AGAIN, raced wide early, then was eased in the drive.
