ILLUSION OF SPEED showed good and set the pace while off the inside, vied three wide on the turn, shook clear under right hand urging in upper stretch and held well under steady handling. CALMED settled off the pace, moved out leaving the backstretch, was urged along while four then five wide on the turn, dropped in while under strong urging in upper stretch and finished willingly to just get the place. FIRY MISTRESS settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and also finished willingly but missed the place. LEE CITY chased the early pace, raced just off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. OH WHATA HOLIDAY lacked early speed, was ridden along while five then six wide on the turn and failed to rally. HEY MY BABY was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and failed to respond. DEBRIS stumbled at the start, moved up while urged along, chased five wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then came up empty. THE PIPSTER chased the early pace, engaged the leader while four wide on the turn, vied into the stretch and capitulated.
