DOWN WITH DIXIE well handled on the lead, was clearly best. ENDORSEMENT three wide around the first turn, continued out from the rail down the backstretch, moved up four wide around the second turn, then while no match for the winner, was best of the rest. NORTHERN GIANT close up, moved up three wide around the second turn, then had no late response. GRANDAD BUD three wide around the first turn, moved to the inside after entering the backstretch, continued inside until nearing the drive, angled out and hung. STERN raced inside and could make little impact. TENPLUS saved ground to no avail. SHELTOWEE well back to before the drive, swung widest and was no real threat. BWANA MOJA was outrun. SPOON RIVER LEW was never dangerous. ELLE UNION prompted the pace to the drive, then gave way. MINE TRAIN raced wide.
