Footnotes

ORIZA was hustled from the start, crossed in front of the field then was taken in hand, set the pace while under a hold, responded well when asked in upper stretch, shook off PLEASANT PACKY and held sway under strong urging. PLEASANT PACKY bumped with a rival at the start, raced inside on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, ranged up while two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, dropped behind the winner while under urging near the three-sixteenths pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. WING A DING was bumped on both sides at the start, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. UNCLE BOOTY bumped with a rival after the start, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn, came off the rail nearing the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. BLUE TWISTER broke out and bumped with WING A DING, raced inside on the first turn, was reserved well back in the field, remained in hand while behind horses on the far turn, was roused near the quarter-pole and improved position. GRAND MINIT went three wide on the first turn, raced towards the front of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and weakened. SPRUCE'S SPIRIT broke a bit slow, lagged well

back in the field, swung five wide into the stretch and never reached contention. MARK SAFELY bumped hard with rivals after the start, raced three then four wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, went three wide on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. HE'S A SLEWVESCENT followed the leader early then raced towards the front of the field, dropped back while off the rail on the far turn and gave way. AGAINSTALLIDES bumped hard with a rival after the start then stumbled and was taken up, raced five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. CEE BAILEY ZOOM broke very slow, spotted the field several lengths, dropped well behind and trailed.
