LEESTOWN GIFT was urged along on the inside, came off the rail late on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to make a bid inside the furlong marker, dueled with EVERY SUNDAY and HIGH TONED while on the outside late and gamely prevailed. EVERY SUNDAY showed good speed, moved clear early then was taken in hand, relinquished the lead to FAREWELL BROADWAY, chased that rival on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, inched clear in upper stretch, dueled gamely on the inside late and was denied. HIGH TONED chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, made a bid near the eighth-pole, dueled gamely between rivals late and just missed in a three-way photo. YUKON BANDIT was urged along on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick. MARK SAFELY was ridden along in the back half of the field, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole and reached his best stride too late while gaining. FAREWELL BROADWAY moved up to take the lead, set the clear pace, lost the advantage at the top of the stretch and weakened. BIDDER DREAMS broke awkwardly and about two lengths behind the field, saved ground towards the rear and finished with good energy. CAJUN DUST lacked early speed, raced three then two wide on the turn, moved out inside the furlong marker and finished with good late energy. HE'S A SLEWVESCENT was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. SILENT COUNT brushed with a rival after the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and also failed to rally. TRAINING ROOM was urged along towards the front, raced two then three wide on the turn and tired. FLYING IDE brushed with a rival after the start, was ridden along on the far outside, raced six then seven wide on the turn, drifted eight wide into the stretch and was no factor. EL CASCADOR was ridden along towards the rear, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
