Footnotes

BUBBLING SPRINGS raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced two then three wide on the far turn, closed well to make a bid in upper stretch, dueled with GOWDEN MILE into the final sixteenth then edged clear under strong urging. GOWDEN MILE raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, advanced on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, made a bid near three-sixteenths pole, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while clear for the place. MR. ROAD WARRIOR bumped lightly with a rival at the start then bumped with ANNA'S GLORY, was hard held on the first turn, moved up between rivals with five furlongs to run, contested the pace, vied inside on the far turn, lost touch with the top two entering the final furlong and weakened while best of the rest. LUCKY TRADITION bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied outside on the far turn, battled into upper stretch then tired. ANNA'S GLORY bumped with MR. ROAD WARRIOR after the start, lingered well back in the field, was urged along on the far turn and failed to threaten. KARMA DISTRACTION contested the pace on the inside, dropped back nearing the half-mile pole, raced inside on the far turn and gave way. SAVIANO was rated just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. JACK AND MAX went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. ALVIN AND DAVID was caught six wide on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch, went five then four wide on the far turn and retreated. GONE LA. raced five wide on the first turn, was through after three furlongs and stopped.
