GERRY'S REWARD bumped lightly with PERFECT PRAISE at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, kicked clear in upper stretch, drifted in near the furlong marker and drew away under strong left hand urging. PERFECT PRAISE bumped lightly with GERRY'S REWARD at the start, chose the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, came under urging on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and proved no match while well clear for the place. SURELY GRAND went to the front, set the pace on an easy lead while on the inside, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, dropped back under a drive and tired while able to hold the show. KIA'S INTIMIDATOR settled on the inside, moved up near the five-eighths pole, was urged along while inside on the far turn, shifted off the rail outside the quarter-pole and came up empty. WHAT A SIGHT settled while off the inside, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. I KNOW WHEN TO RUN was taken up at the start, raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was hard ridden while inside on the far turn and showed little.
