PROUD STRIKE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced three wide on the far turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch, drifted in near the furlong marker and drew away under strong urging. PERFECT TITLE lagged at the rear of the field while under some urging, shifted four wide approaching the three-eighths pole, moved to five wide around the five-sixteenths and got up for the place. DOC ALMON bumped with GET IN LINE entering the first turn, went four then three wide on that bend, moved up on the outside, made a bid while three then two wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and proved no match for the winner then lost the place. A BETTER TOMORROW was bumped very hard at the start, saved ground on the first turn, moved up outside the half-mile pole, was urged along on the far turn and came up empty. CRUZADO bumped very hard with rivals at the start, set the clear pace while on the inside, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. NIGHT PATROL bumped hard with SHORT STORY LONG entering the first turn, saved ground on that bend, settled off the pace, lost position leaving the backstretch, was urged along on the far turn and failed to respond. COUNTERBLOW settled towards the rear, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. HY DANGER went three wide on the first turn, lingered near the back, went three wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to three wide late on the bend and failed to threaten. GET IN LINE broke out and hit the gate then bumped very hard with CRUZADO, bumped with rivals entering the first turn, raced three then two wide on that bend, moved closer outside the five-eighths pole, dropped back while urged along on the far turn and faded. SHORT STORY LONG bumped hard with rivals on both sides entering the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and retreated.
