Footnotes

SO DO PRAYERS moved up to take the lead, set the pace under some pressure, vied inside on the turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, duelled gamely with TREAD in the stretch and narrowly prevailed. TREAD raced up close on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, duelled gamely with SO DO PRAYERS in the stretch and was denied. PRETTY PETAL chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and finished willingly for the show. ANAHAUC was last away, raced well off the pace while ridden along, went three then four wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, brushed with ORLAND FLASH inside the three-sixteenths pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. ORLAND FLASH was urged along while off the pace, advanced four to five wide on the turn, brushed with ANAHAUC inside the three-sixteenths pole and weakened. MIDNIGHT RIDER showed early speed then tracked the pace, made a bid while two to three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. SMART DANCER lacked speed while ridden along on the far outside, went five then four wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and was no factor. WATERCOLORS was urged along while off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn and failed to respond. UNRIVALED HONOR broke near the back of the field, was ridden along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and showed little.
