Footnotes

JOHNNY HANDSOME went three wide on the first turn, was unhurried off the pace, shifted five wide near the three-eighths pole, advanced on the outside, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled while lugging in a bit and edged clear late under strong urging. ONE KING'S MAN went four then three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while just able to get the place. PASSING SIMON went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole but was also outfinished then just missed the place. PURE PEGASUS was well rated while setting the pace off the rail, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead and gave way. MY NATIVE BLUES saved ground on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside while under some urging on the far turn, came off the rail while behind a wall of horses at the top of the stretch and came up empty. ALWAYS BROKE lagged well behind and showed little. TRAGERS TRIGGER steadied between rivals early on the first turn, went two then three wide on that bend, settled off the pace, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
