VENOMOUS forwardly placed along the inside, continued inside until nearing the drive, was eased out, rallied back to the inside, responded to strong handling and prevailed. CLOCK STOPPER slow away, was unhurried while outrun, swung out for the drive, loomed approaching the final sixteenth but could not overtake the top one. METEOR IMPACT forwardly placed four wide, rallied in upper stretch, gained the edge and then had no final kick. SMALLTOWN SLEW well back to the drive, swung out and made a late gain. SANTANA STRINGS out footed, lacked a response. MONKEY HILL raced wide and had no finish. PRIVATE VOW forwardly placed to reaching mid stretch, gave way. STORM SURGE showed speed to the drive and then weakened. RODEO'S CASTLE moved clear early, was overtaken approaching the drive and then stopped.
