Footnotes

TOUGH OPERATOR showed good speed, set the pace, vied inside on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and drew off under urging then was eased up late. WILMA'S NUMBERONE was sent hard from the start, chased the pace, raced near the inside on the turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. SHINEMAN was ridden along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn, was forced out near the furlong marker and secured the show.. ROYAL DEBUT was urged along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and failed to rally. BIG OIL'S REVENGE was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and also failed to rally. SALTY LYDGATE bumped with a rival at the start and was last away, raced well back in the field, moved out in upper stretch, steadied behind rivals near the sixteenth-pole and failed to threaten. PORT IN CHINA bumped lightly with a rival after the start then was in tight, raced off the pace while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and also failed to threaten. BENEDABOUNTYHUNTER bumped lightly with a rival at the start, was ridden along towards the front, raced three to four wide on the turn, drifted out under

left hand urging near the furlong marker, jostled with SHINEMAN and came up empty. ROYALEE BRED brushed with a rival after the start, raced well back in the field, went two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. BANKING WOES chased the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn and capitulated. KNOTTY SORCERER bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the turn and showed little.
