GRAND ILLUMINATION was away alertly from the outside post, raced in second position while urged along, chased on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and held well under strong urging. HIDATSA settled on the inside, saved ground on the turn, shifted three wide nearing the quarter-pole, was put to a drive, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was second best. THRUTHEGARDENGATE set the clear pace, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired while clear for the show. HORSCHER settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. PEARL PENDANT stumbled at the start and was off a couple of lengths slow, raced well back in the field and was no factor. DEBORAH'S MOMENT settled on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. (RACE CONTESTED FOR PURSE MONEY ONLY)
