MARK VALESKI was last away, raced on the outside while ridden along, went four wide on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, dueled with RADIANT TALENT in the stretch and proved best under strong urging. RADIANT TALENT tracked the pace, chased three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, dueled with MARK VALESKI in the stretch and was outfinished late while well clear for the place. ADENA'S CHANCE was ridden along while off the pace, steadied along the rail nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. SEEKER showed good speed, set the pace, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole and gave way. SIMON RIDGE was well placed just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. OUR FINAL CHANCE was very fractious in the gate, dropped well behind the field, raced two then three wide on the turn and was no factor.
