Footnotes

RUNAWAY DIXIE raced just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, looked to move outside coming to the quarter-pole but was presented with an opening along the rail, rallied to the lead inside the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging. MYSTERY STREET set the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while just able to get the place. CITY THYMES was last away then ridden along near the back, went four wide on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and finished with good energy to just miss the place. MAGIC APPOINTMENT chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. IT'S NOT FAIR raced towards the rear, went three wide on the turn, angled out inside the quarter-pole and improved position. JO JO'S LEG'S raced towards the front while under some restraint, went three wide on the turn, came under strong urging near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. TWISTED NICKIE was urged along near the back, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. WHISTLING BRAHMS was urged along in the front half of the field, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn and failed to respond. LITTLE RED ASHE raced towards the rear, saved ground on the turn, maneuvered around the stopping PEDAL TO THE MOON in upper stretch and never reached contention. GERALDNEVERSLEEPS broke out and bobbled slightly, was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. LEESTOWN FLASH was ridden along while off the pace, dropped back while three wide on

the turn and also failed to respond. PEDAL TO THE MOON chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail at the top of the stretch and stopped then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
