BAUERS GOT HOURS moved out early on the backstretch, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under good handling. TINNER raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader down the backstretch, chased while off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, was put to an all out drive, closed well to loom a threat into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while able to secure the place. NECAISE set the clear pace, was asked to pick it up near the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when asked for more in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into the final furlong but was overtaken while able to save the show. TWILIGHT BAY bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, brushed with ELUSIVE COMMANDER inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. ELUSIVE COMMANDER was reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, brushed with TWILIGHT BAY inside the furlong marker and also lacked the needed kick. ROCK HARD settled at the rear of the field while near the inside, drafted at the back of the field leaving the far turn, was roused at the top of stretch and failed to rally. MUSICSTREET MENACE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while five wide on the far turn and also failed to rally. ENGINE ROOM threw his head when taken up entering the first turn, raced four wide on that turn, settled in the front half of the field, was urged along between rivals on the far turn and came up empty. BRAVO WHISKEY raced towards the inside on the first turn, settled nicely in third position, was urged along while inside on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 20 Feet)
