MISTER H was urged along on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled with WHO DAT MAX into the final sixteenth then edged clear under strong urging. WHO DAT MAX was hustled from the start, set the clear pace along the rail, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled with MISTER H into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to hold the place. RADICAL IDEA chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. JONESICULA brushed with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and also lacked the needed kick. SURF CAST chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. CHEROKEE OUTLAW was ridden along towards the rear, raced three to four wide on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. GOING FOR ERN was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn and failed to threaten. CALIUS brushed with a rival at the start, was void of speed, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. FINE TROUBLEMAKER was ridden along near the back, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and showed little. BILLY BO was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn and came up empty.
