CHEROKEE QUEEN was reserved at the back of the field, advanced five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, was put to a drive while well out in the course, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to win going away. JUANITA raced inside on the first turn, tracked the pace outside on the backstretch, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, drifted out some while in front, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while able to get the place. PLEASANTLY BLESSED went three wide on the first turn, settled between rivals on the backstretch, bided her time while three wide on the far turn, waited behind rivals coming into the stretch, was asked near the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy to just miss the place. WEEKEND PARTY raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, was well rated while setting the pace, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened. A SHE'S ADORABLE settled towards the rear, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. SKIPPING TOWN settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and came up empty. MISS SHANANIEGANS settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. COUNTESS LEMONADE went four wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, went four wide on the far turn, waited briefly near the five-sixteenths pole then dropped to three wide, came under a drive in upper stretch and failed to respond. POOF TOO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. (Rail at 25 Feet)
