JERRY THE GENIUS fractious in the gate prior to the start, got away slowly, moved up down the backstretch, then was no real threat. GENUINE SPARK raced wide. KD'S VALID DREAMER raced wide. LOUISIANA PLAYBOY was never dangerous.
