FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. No nomination fee. \$300 to enter and \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 11% to third; 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non winners of \$45,000 since December 15, 2010 allowed 2 lbs. \$25,000 since November 15, 2010 allowed 4 lbs. \$18,000 since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances) Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2010-2011. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Saturday, January 1, 2011, with 14 nominations. (S)

### Footnotes

SPEEDACIOUS was hustled to the lead, set the clear pace while off the inside, drifted out while extending the advantage in the stretch and proved much the best while ridden out. CAJUN CONFERENCE showed early speed then tracked the leader, was urged along while inside on the turn, came out inside the quarter-pole and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. CHERRY FOREVER was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and came up empty while best of the rest. ANYTHING BUT QUIET was recalcitrant behind the gate and reluctant to load, raced at the rear of the field while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. THRU THE GARDENGATE chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and tired. SHUTUPANDDANCE was ridden along while off the pace, raced near the inside on the turn and failed to respond.
