FOR FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. No Nomination Fee; \$300 to enter; \$300 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 since December 15th, allowed 2 lbs. \$25,000 since November 15th, allowed 4 lbs. \$18,000 since then, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2010-2011. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 starters. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to an exclusion of a single interest. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Saturday, January 1, 2011, with 13 nominations. (S)

CHIEF JAY was reserved off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed strongly under left hand urging, took the lead near the sixteenth-pole and held off the fast closing FLASHY WISE CAT under strong handling. FLASHY WISE CAT dropped back at the start, settled at the rear of the field, raced three then four wide on the turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed strongly under right hand urging and just missed. MY STAR RUNNER followed the solo leader while in hand, ranged up while still in hand on the turn, moved to the lead in upper stretch, was asked outside the furlong marker, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the show. MR. PORTER dropped back after the start, settled towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. FOREIGN PRODUCTION was hustled from the start, quickly sprinted clear, raced inside on the turn, was asked for more near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. DOWN THE ROAD settled off the pace, raced inside on the turn and failed to respond.
