SAINT WILL bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn, rallied under a drive in upper stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled with ISLAND SOUL while being carried inward in the final furlong and gamely prevailed. ISLAND SOUL bumped lightly with a rival at the start, settled at the rear of the field, went two then three wide on the turn, shifted five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside while under a drive, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled with SAINT WILL while drifting inward in the final furlong and just missed. MR. FUZZYBOTTOM was well placed behind the leaders, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, held a short lead into the final furlong but was outfinished while clear for the show. KITTY'S TURN showed early speed then pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and tired. TAKING CHARGE settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. RATATAT moved up after the start, set the pace under pressure, vied off the rail on the turn and gave way. SOARING NATIVE broke awkwardly then stumbled and unseated the rider.
