CLASSIC COZZENE allowed to settle, advanced nearing the drive, angled out four wide, closed determinedly and was up in the final strides. SUPER SAN SAN within striking distance, was sent after YOU ARE CHARMING before the final turn, surged to command turning for home and just failed to last. DEFENSIVE DAME trailed early, moved up around the final turn, eased out and was late outside the top two. SAM'S LADY devoid of early foot, rallied six wide in upper stretch and passed tiring rivals. BETHASTAN unhurried while outrun, appeared a threat in mid stretch and weakened. REAL GLO allowed to settle, offered her best five wide turning for home and faded. LIZZY'S A DREAM saved ground early, moved out down the backstretch and failed to menace. NORA'S NIGHTMARE close up for six furlongs, gave way. YOU ARE CHARMING sprinted to a lengthy lead, weakened readily once headed. MILDRED'S LIST dropped back quickly and was distanced. DIVA RIDGE steadied entering the first turn, recovered, dropped back and was distanced.
