EVER AFTER never far back, advanced between foes around the second turn, angled out four wide turning for home, took over the lead before mid stretch, lugged in badly to the rail and proved best under strong left handed pressure. EVROBI wearing a nasal strip, unhurried while outrun, found her best stride late and rallied gamely mid track. AZIREPRICE stalked the leader from early on and gave way grudgingly. ZOFTIG settled early, advanced from the rail down the backstretch, rallied between foes in the drive and showed late interest. SOIREE LADY devoid of early foot, advanced five wide around the second turn and hung. MRS EIGHT O THREE had no speed and was not a threat. PULPIT HARBOR close up from the rail, faded. GRASP set the pace and faltered in the drive. MY QUEEN BURNS three wide early, raced forward while continuing out from the rail, loomed boldly a quarter out and stopped. MAXIMUM ADVANCE three wide early, showed little. ALWAYS COOL three wide early, raced forward down the backstretch, made a run four wide nearing the drive and then stopped. BLUE'S BABY was outrun.
