SKIPPING TOWN raced four wide on the first turn, set the pace while under a snug hold, vied four wide on the far turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. EXQUISITE (NZ) prompted the pace on the inside, vied inside on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and proved no match while just able to get the place. IN THE SLIPS settled off the pace while off the rail, was urged along while between rivals on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, failed to match strides with the winner and just missed the place. THIRD DAWN raced three then two wide on the first turn, lingered towards the rear of the field, was roused at the top of the stretch, came between rivals near the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy but just missed the minor awards. SIMPLE SPEED raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled at the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MAY ONE settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. TRUE BREW was caught five wide early on the initial turn then dropped in, was well placed just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and also came up empty. SOMME was carried six wide into the first turn then dropped to four wide, raced off the pace while under restraint, went four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. VERA BELLE was rank while hard held early, raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, was reserved off the pace, went five wide on the far turn, was put to the whip at the top of the stretch and had nothing left.
