Footnotes

HOT ZAPPER went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, raced between rivals while three wide early on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths then moved four wide, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, drifted in while moving clear into the final furlong and drew away under strong urging. HAIL TO THE NILE went four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths pole, battled under a drive in upper stretch, proved no match for the winner in the final furlong and held the place while drifting out late. BLUE FORTY TWO contested the pace through moderate fractions while near the inside, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. LORI'S DARLING went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced towards the rail on the far turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole and improved position without threatening. COURTNEY'S PRINCE saved ground on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, raced off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide approaching the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response while under a drive and tired. FOREINFINITY went three wide on the first turn, disputed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and gave way. PUMMILL went three then two wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, came under some urging midway down the backstretch, raced between rivals on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch and capitulated. DAVID'S HONOR raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was rated just behind the leader while into the bit, saved ground while under urging on the far turn and had nothing left. DREWSSASIN was away awkwardly, raced five to six wide on both turns and was no factor. SO RUSTON bumped with RAZORBACK BLEND while savaging that rival nearing the first turn, lingered well back and was outrun. RAZORBACK BLEND bumped with SO RUSTON early, lagged well back

and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
