COLORMEGREEN sprinted clear early, was collared nearing mid stretch and lasted for second. BRITTSKER chased the leader for early on and lacked the needed kick three wide. QUANAH saved ground throughout and lacked the needed finish. WAVERLY BELL saved ground to the lane, angled out four wide and hung. HOLY NOLA bounced around early, trailed and showed some late interest. SHEER SABLE unhurried early, had no rally. KATE'S PROPHECY raced wide. TAFT LIL QUEEN between rivals, gave way. CHRIS'S THUNDER had no speed and was not a threat. HUMBLE RETHA always back.
