Footnotes

UNTHINKABLE four wide early, was steered to the inside entering the first turn, settled just behind the leaders, eased out around the second turn, bid outside MARTHA MARTHA in mid stretch and proved clearly best. ALY'S EVENT reserved until the second turn, rallied outside and got up for second. MARTHA MARTHA three wide around the first turn, was unhurried outside the leaders, bid around the second turn, shook clear entering the drive and then weakened late. LUPE'S LOVE devoid speed, was no real threat. NATIVE MILLU reserved, had no response. LADY LIVEY BODGIT got clear early around the first turn, was collared before the drive and then faltered. CALL ME JOYCE trailed much of the trip and was no factor. GOLDEN TRUMPET showed speed to the second turn and then faltered.
