EL'S PROMISE bumped soundly with POLISH LIGHT at the start, was urged along towards the front, raced two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a strong drive, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under strong urging. GO BABY BOY chased the pace on the outside, gained the lead while three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, inched clear near the three-sixteenths pole, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and weakened while just able to hold the place. BET I'LL B BETTER bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. IN MOTION was reluctant to load then hustled from the start, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn and tired. KASOS PRIDE bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. SOVIET AFLEET was hustled from the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied between rivals on the turn and capitulated. MINESTRIKE was ridden along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and came up empty. THE TEPIT was void of speed, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. POLISH LIGHT bumped soundly with EL'S PROMISE at the start, was ridden along in the back half of the field, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. ITS A PRIVILEGE was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on

the turn and failed to respond. SUPAFLY TY dropped back in the early going, raced well back in the field, went five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and was outrun. SNUCK THREE broke a bit slow then was slow into stride, raced well back in the field, came four wide into the stretch and showed little.
