COOL STREET broke a bit slow, settled towards the rear while off the rail, was ridden along on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up at the wire. GOSPEL LESSON went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while two to three wide on the far turn, battled with STREET SERENADE in the stretch and just missed. STREET SERENADE was well rated while setting the pace, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, battled gamely with GOSPEL LESSON and also just missed. ADULARE went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and finished willingly. GOODTIMEHADBYALL settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. ADIOS NARDO broke out and about two lengths slow, went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear while well out in the track, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. TYCOON saved ground on the first turn, settled nicely in the middle of the field, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond.
