MATCHING WHITES broke alertly, settled while off the rail down the backstretch, rallied four wide for the drive, gained the edge a furlong out and then drew clear late. MATZ vied between foes to nearing mid stretch, then was narrowly second. COOL HERO vied for the lead three wide, gained the edge turning for home, got headed and then missed second. SILVER INDY trailed to the drive, then passed beaten foes. K C SHUFFLE raced inside to little avail. BIMINI TWIST was outrun. TIDE RISING hustled up to vie for the lead from the inside to the drive, then faltered inside the final furlong. REALLY DID BAM was never dangerous.
