STORM OSIDY brushed with a rival at the start, raced just behind the leader while between rivals, went two then three wide on the turn, ranged up approaching the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, battled with LIL NICHOLAS into the final sixteenth and inched clear under strong urging. LIL NICHOLAS set the pace under pressure, inched clear passing the half-mile pole, raced inside on the turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch, battled determinedly into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while clear for the place. SOCIALLYCHALLENGED broke out at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, chased on the turn and tired while able to get the show. TOP CATS BULL brushed with a rival at the start, pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back passing the half-mile pole, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole and weakened. THE REVEREND JAMES was taken back early then reserved off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. THISONESFOMYNINJAS dropped back at the start, fell well behind the rest of the field, raced near the inside on the turn and trailed.
