Footnotes

BUILT TO PRECISION went two to three wide on the first turn, drew off to a commanding lead, remained well clear while two to three wide on the far turn, was asked near the three-sixteenths pole and proved much the best under vigorous hand urging. J. BURLE raced inside on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and narrowly earned the place. CORNICELLI lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and just missed the place. HOWELL PARK went three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. MAGNET COVE raced three wide on the first turn, moved into second passing the half-mile pole, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. UNCLE ROSE raced four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, went five wide on the far turn and faltered. GREEN CARD JAMES faltered on the second turn and was pulled up then walked off.
