BRESSIE set the pace while in hand, lost the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, was asked passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled gamely on the inside in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. LITTLE PINKIE went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three then four wide on the far turn, brushed with a rival at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, closed gradually on the outside, loomed boldly entering the final sixteenth but just missed. FLEUR DE SEL was rated off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid without being asked in upper stretch, was asked inside the furlong marker, battled with three rivals and also missed. DARKEST HOUR raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, stalked the pace, took the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, battled between rivals in the stretch and was outfinished late. READY INTEREST went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, brushed with a rival at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed kick. G G'S GIRL threw her head when taken in hand early, raced inside on the first turn, settled down the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the far turn and failed to rally. MOLLY MOON raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four then three wide on the far turn and faltered.
