Footnotes

HOPEFUL NOTION contested the lead on the inside of EXECUTIVE CALL, dropped back near the five-eighths pole, was well placed behind the aforementioned rival, raced inside on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, made a bid near the eighth-pole, dueled gamely in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. EXECUTIVE CALL went four then three wide while in hand on the first turn, moved to a clear lead while into the bit with five furlongs to run, was well rated in front, raced off the rail on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, dueled gamely with the winner in the final furlong, drifted out under vigorous left hand urging late and just missed. RUNAWAY BINGO went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased three wide on the far turn, pursued the top two in upper stretch and was no match for those rivals while clear for the show. DIXIE FORTY FIVE bumped with SON HONEY at the start, bumped hard with that rival twice nearing the first turn, was in tight late on the initial bend then reserved off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch and tired. SHELBY SCOTT bumped hard with BROTHER RAY RAY just after the start, went five wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced four wide while under

urging on the far turn and came up empty. SON HONEY bumped with DIXIE FORTY FIVE at the start, bumped hard twice with that rival early, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn and capitulated. DEADLY TRUTH went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along on the far turn, shifted out near the furlong marker and failed to threaten. MACH TWO DOC broke through the gate prior to the start, went five wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide approaching the quarter-pole and failed to respond. BIEN BON bumped hard with BROTHER RAY RAY just after the start, went six wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, lingered near the back, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. CAREFULLY WORDED broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, dropped back early on the backstretch, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and faded. IDOL CAT went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the far turn and was no factor. BROTHER RAY RAY was bumped hard on both sides just after the start then checked sharply, went three wide early on the first turn then shifted six wide, raced near the back while on the far outside, went six wide on the far turn and faltered.
