Footnotes

IMPOSING GRACE settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, rallied along the rail, took a couple of awkward strides while hesitant to go through inside of YOUNG AND LOVELY at the furlong marker, moved through to take the lead inside the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. YOUNG AND LOVELY broke out then was hustled, went to the front, opened up a huge lead, saw the margin diminish leaving the far turn, was asked for her best in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to hold the place. DEVIOUS INTENT settled behind the clear leader, was asked on the far turn, gained ground into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and was outfinished while clear for the show. ANDROEAH went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn, advanced into upper stretch but lacked the needed kick. SILVER AMI went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while three then four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. EVEN FOREST was a bit slow into stride, settled towards the rear, was roused on the far turn and failed to threaten. SPUN RIBBON bobbled ever so slightly at the start, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved in third position, raced three wide while under urging on the far turn and failed to rally.
