CLASSY COVE set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, shook off PHYSICAL GOLD nearing the furlong marker and held gamely under strong urging. EDDIE'S BAND settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, drafted behind the pacesetter late on the bend, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch, moved closer while in hand, was asked while brushing with PHYSICAL GOLD approaching the eighth-pole, chased the winner on the outside and finished willingly but missed. BIGIN broke a bit slow, settled towards the rear, was roused while three wide on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. PHYSICAL GOLD brushed with an opponent at the start, pressed the pace, drew even passing the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, brushed with EDDIE'S BAND coming to the furlong marker and weakened. JEFF was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SPACE TRAVELER broke out at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn and gave way.
